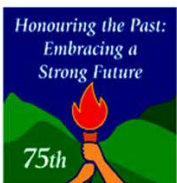
## U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Seeks Public Comment on Water Strategy to Respond to Climate Change

Until May 27, 2008, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is seeking public comment on a draft strategy that describes the potential effects of climate change on clear water, drinking water and ocean protection programs, and outlines EPA actions to respond to these effects.

The strategy identifies contributions that water programs can make to mitigate greenhouse gases. Some of the potential impacts of climate change on water resources reviewed in the strategy include increases in certain water pollution problems, changes in availability of drinking water supplies and collective impacts on coastal areas.
